2. And there was a certain man of Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren, and bore not. 3. And the angel of Hashem appeared to the woman, and said to her, Behold now, you are barren, and bear not; but you shall conceive, and bear a son. 4. Now therefore beware, I beseech you, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean thing; 5. For, behold, you shall conceive, and bear a son; and no razor shall come on his head; for the child shall be a Nazirite to Elohim from the womb; and he shall begin to save Israel from the hand of the Philistines. 6. Then the woman came and told her husband, saying, A man of Elohim came to me, and his countenance was like the countenance of an angel of Elohim, very awesome; but I asked him not from where he was, nor did he tell me his name; 7. But he said to me, Behold, you shall conceive, and bear a son; and now do not drink wine nor strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing; for the child shall be a Nazirite to Elohim from the womb to the day of his death. 8. Then Manoah entreated Hashem, and said, O my Hashem, let the man of Elohim whom you sent come back to us, and teach us what we shall do with the child who shall be born. 9. And Elohim listened to the voice of Manoah; and the angel of Elohim came back to the woman as she sat in the field; but Manoah her husband was not with her. 10. And the woman made haste, and ran, and told her husband, and said to him, Behold, the man, who came to see me the other day, has appeared to me. 11. And Manoah arose, and went after his wife, and came to the man, and said to him, Are you the man who spoke to the woman? And he said, I am. 12. And Manoah said, Now let your words come to pass. What shall be the rule for the child, and what shall be done with him? 13. And the angel of Hashem said to Manoah, Of all that I said to the woman let her beware. 14. She may not eat of any thing that comes of the vine, nor let her drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing; all that I commanded her let her observe. 15. And Manoah said to the angel of Hashem, I beseech you, let us detain you, until we shall have prepared a kid for you. 16. And the angel of Hashem said to Manoah, Though you detain me, I will not eat of your bread; and if you will offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to Hashem. For Manoah knew not that he was an angel of Hashem. 17. And Manoah said to the angel of Hashem, What is your name, that when your sayings come to pass we may do you honor? 18. And the angel of Hashem said to him, Why ask you thus after my name, seeing it is hidden? 19. So Manoah took a kid with a meal offering, and offered it upon a rock to Hashem; and the angel did wondrously; and Manoah and his wife looked on. 20. For it came to pass, when the flame went up toward heaven from off the altar, that the angel of Hashem ascended in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife looked on it, and fell on their faces to the ground. 21. But the angel of Hashem did

no more appear to Manoah and to his wife. Then Manoah knew that he was an angel of Hashem. 22. And Manoah said to his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen Elohim. 23. But his wife said to him, If Hashem would have been pleased to kill us, he would not have received a burnt offering and a meal offering from our hands, nor would he have shown us all these things, nor would have told us, at this time, such things as these. 24. And the woman bore a son, and called his name Samson; and the child grew, and Hashem blessed him. 25. And the spirit of Hashem began to stir him in Mahaneh-Dan, between Zorah and Eshtaol.
