46. And the hand of Hashem was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

Chapter 19

1. And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and how he had killed all the prophets with the sword. 2. Then Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah, saying, So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not your life as the life of one of them by tomorrow about this time. 3. And when he saw that, he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which belongs to Judah, and left his servant there. 4. But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree; and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O Hashem, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers. 5. And as he lay and slept under a broom tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said to him, Arise and eat. 6. And he looked, and, behold, there was a cake baked on the coals, and a jar of water at his head. And he ate and drank, and laid himself down again. 7. And the angel of Hashem came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat; because the journey is too great for you. 8. And he arose, and ate and drank, and went in the strength of that meal forty days and forty nights to Horeb the mount of Elohim. 9. And he came there to a cave, and lodged there; and, behold, the word of Hashem came to him, and he said to him, What are you doing here, Elijah? 10. And he said, I have been very zealous for Hashem Elohim of hosts; for the people of Israel have forsaken your covenant, thrown down your altars, and killed your prophets with the sword; and I am the only one left; and they seek my life, to take it away. 11. And he said, Go out, and stand upon the mount before Hashem. And, behold, Hashem passed by, and a great and strong wind tore the mountains, and broke in pieces the rocks before Hashem; but Hashem was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake; but Hashem was not in the earthquake; 12. And after the earthquake a fire; but Hashem was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice. 13. And it was so, when Elijah heard it that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entrance of the cave. And, behold, there came a voice to him, and said, What are you doing here, Elijah? 14. And he said, I have been very zealous for Hashem Elohim of hosts; because the people of Israel have forsaken your covenant,

thrown down your altars, and killed your prophets with the sword; and I am the only one left; and they seek my life, to take it away. 15. And Hashem said to him, Go, return on your way to the wilderness of Damascus; and when you come, anoint Hazael to be king over Aram; 16. And Jehu the son of Nimshi shall you anoint to be king over Israel; and Elisha the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah shall you anoint to be prophet in your place. 17. And it shall come to pass, that he who escapes the sword of Hazael shall Jehu slay; and he who escapes from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay. 18. Yet I have left me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed to Baal, and every mouth who has not kissed him. 19. And he departed from there, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he with the twelfth; and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him. 20. And he left the oxen, and ran after Elijah, and said, Let me, I pray you, kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow you. And he said to him, Go and come back again; for what have I done to you? 21. And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave to the people, and they ate. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and attended to him.
