# לִזְרַע וְלֶחֶם לְאֹכֵל:

1. Ho, every one who thirsts, come to the waters, and he who has no money; come, buy, and eat; come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. 2. Why do you spend money for that which is not bread? And your labor for that which satisfies not? Listen diligently to me, and eat that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness. 3. Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure loving promises of David. 4. Behold, I have made him a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people. 5. Behold, you shall call a nation that you know not, and nations that did not know you shall run to you because of Hashem your Elohim, and for the Holy One of Israel; for he has glorified you. 6. Seek Hashem while he may be found, call upon him while he is near; 7. Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return to Hashem, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our Elohim, for he will abundantly pardon. 8. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says Hashem. 9. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. 10. For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and returns not there, but waters the earth, and makes it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater;
