1. And the days of David drew near that he should die; and he charged Solomon his son, saying, 2. I go the way of all the earth; be you strong therefore, and show yourself a man; 3. And keep the charge of the Lord your God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the Torah of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do, and wherever you turn yourself; 4. That the Lord may continue his word which he spoke concerning me, saying, If your children take heed to their way, to walk before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there shall not fail you, said he, a man on the throne of Israel. 5. And also you know what Joab the son of Zeruah did to me, and what he did to the two captains of the armies of Israel, to Abner, the son of Ner, and to Amasa, the son of Jether, whom he killed, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle around his loins, and in his shoes that were on his feet. 6. Do therefore according to your wisdom, and let not his grey head go down to Sheol in peace. 7. But show kindness to the sons of Barzilai the Gileadite, and let them be of those who eat at your table; for so they came to me when I fled because of Absalom your brother. 8. And, behold, you have with you Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite of Bahurim, who cursed me with a grievous curse in the day when I went to Mahanaim; but he came down to meet me at the Jordan, and I swore to him by the Lord, saying, I will not put you to death with the sword. 9. And therefore hold him not guiltless; for you are a wise man, and know what you ought to do to him; but his grey head bring down to Sheol with blood. 10. And David slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David. 11. And the days that David reigned over Israel were forty years; seven years he reigned in Hebron, and thirty three years he reigned in Jerusalem. 12. And Solomon sat on the throne of David his father; and his kingdom was firmly established.
