4. Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant to Hashem, as in the days of old, and as in former years. 5. And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those who oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the orphan, and who turn aside the foreigner from his right, and do not fear me, says Hashem of hosts. 6. For I am Hashem, I do not change; therefore you sons of Jacob are not consumed. 7. From the days of your fathers you have turned aside from my ordinances, and have not kept them. Return to me, and I will return to you, says Hashem of hosts. But you said, How shall we return? 8. Will man rob Elohim? Yet you have robbed me. But you say, How have we robbed you? In tithes and offerings. 9. You are cursed with a curse; for you have robbed me, this whole nation. 10. Bring all the tithes to the storehouse, so that there may be food in my house, and test me now with that, says Hashem of hosts, if I will not open for you the windows of heaven, and pour for you an overflowing blessing. 11. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; nor shall your vine cast her fruit in the field before the time, says Hashem of hosts. 12. And all nations shall call you blessed; for you shall be a land of delight, says Hashem of hosts. 13. Your words have been strong against me, says Hashem. Yet you say, How have we spoken against you? 14. You have said: It is vain to serve Elohim; and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before Hashem of hosts? 15. And now we call the arrogant happy; those who work wickedness prosper; even those who tempt Elohim escape. 16. Then those who feared Hashem spoke to one another; and Hashem listened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for those who feared Hashem, and who took heed of his name. 17. And they shall be mine, says Hashem of hosts, on that day which I appoint as my particular day; and I will spare them, like a man spares his own son who serves him. 18. Then you shall return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him who serves Elohim and him who does not serve him. 19. For, behold, the day comes, it shall burn like an oven; and all the arrogant, and all who do wickedly, shall be stubble; and the day that comes shall burn them up, says Hashem of hosts, so that it will not leave them root nor branch. 20. But to you who fear my name the sun of righteousness shall arise with healing in its wings; and you shall go forth leaping like calves from the stall. 21. And you shall trample down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I shall do this, says Hashem of hosts. 22. Remember the Torah of Moses my servant, which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. 23. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of Hashem; 24. And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the land with a curse.
