15. But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, who kept the charge of my sanctuary when the people of Israel went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister to me, and they shall stand before me to offer to me the fat and the blood, says Hashem Elohim; 16. They shall enter into my sanctuary, and they shall come near to my table, to minister to me, and they shall keep my charge. 17. And it shall come to pass, that when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them, while they minister in the gates of the inner court, and inside. 18. They shall have linen turbans upon their heads, and shall have linen breeches upon their loins; they shall not gird themselves with any thing that causes sweat. 19. And when they go out into the outer court, into the outer court to the people, they shall take off their garments with which they ministered, and lay them in the holy

chambers, and they shall put on other garments; and they shall not sanctify the people with their garments. 20. And they shall not shave their heads, nor let their locks grow long; they shall only trim their heads. 21. And no priest shall drink wine, when they enter into the inner court. 22. And they shall not take widows or divorced women for wives, but they shall take virgins of the seed of the house of Israel, or a widow who is the widow of a priest. 23. And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and the common, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. 24. And in a controversy they act as judges; and they shall judge it according to my judgments; and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all my appointed times; and they shall sanctify my sabbaths. 25. And they shall not defile themselves by coming near to a dead person; however for father, or for mother, or for son, or for daughter, for brother or for a sister who had no husband, they may defile themselves. 26. And after he is cleansed, they shall count to him seven days. 27. And in the day that he goes into the sanctuary, to the inner court, to minister in the sanctuary, he shall offer his sin offering, said Hashem Elohim. 28. And it shall be to them for an inheritance; I am their inheritance; and you shall give them no possession in Israel; I am their possession. 29. They shall eat the meal offering, and the sin offering, and the guilt offering; and every devoted thing in Israel shall be theirs. 30. And the first of all the first fruits of all things, and every offering, of all your offerings, shall belong to the priests; you shall also give to the priest the first of your dough, that he may cause a blessing to rest in your house. 31. The priests shall not eat of any thing that dies of itself, or is torn, whether it is bird or beast.
